This tournament is a London Junior Chess Qualifier

Ipswich Junior Chess Club meets in the canteen at Copleston High School, Ipswich, every Saturday morning from 10 till 11:30 during term time and caters for all abilities and ages of junior chess players.

TOURNAMENT SECTIONS

1. School Year 3 & below (Under 8 at 31st August 2009).
2. Year 4 & 5 (Under 10) (at 31st August 2009)
3. Year 6 & 7, or aged Under 12 (at 31st August 2009)
4. Year 8 & 9, or aged Under 14 (at 31st August 2009)
5. CHALLENGERS (aged 14-18 or stronger younger players)
6. OPEN for any players including adults.

OPEN is for any adults or strong juniors, CHALLENGERS for U18 players with ELO UNDER 1450 (Age as at 31st August 2009)

Players may enter any section for which they qualify by age or rating. The Tournament Organiser reserves the right to place players in the most appropriate section.

ALL THE ORGANISER'S DECISIONS ABOUT THE TOURNAMENT ARE FINAL.

LONDON JUNIOR CHAMPIONSHIPS

Players in the U8, U10 & U12 sections may qualify for the finals of the London Junior event, depending on their score.

RATE OF PLAY

All games will be played with 30 minutes per player per game. Assistance will be given to players not used to clocks.

BYES

Players may request a 1/2 point bye in the first round only, if travelling for the 9.30 start causes difficulty. Otherwise all players play in all rounds (Swiss system).

ELIGIBILITY, ENTRY FEE

The tournament is open to all players under 18 on 31st August 2009. (The Open section has no age restriction).

U8 – U14 sections	£7.50
CHALLENGERS (U1450)	£8.00
OPEN	£10.00 (any age)

Entries received after the 4th November will be subject to a £1 extra charge. Cheques made out to 'Ipswich Junior Chess Club' please.

CLOSING DATE (NO ENTRIES ON THE DAY)

Entries will be accepted up to and including Wednesday 4th November. After this, acceptance of entries will depend on space and payment of £1 late entry fee.

REFRESHMENTS

A range of light refreshments will be available throughout the day.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded based on numbers entered in each section. Ipswich Junior titles will be awarded to players eligible by residence or attendance at a school in Ipswich, or by membership of Ipswich Junior Chess Club. In the OPEN section separate prizes will be awarded to the top under 18 Players. There will be a trophy for the best newcomer.
